Rules and Regulations for Disability Golf Carts

- I. Request for the use of a golf cart for disability owners must be submitted to the B.O.D.'s and the Park Manager for review.
- II. ONLY LOT OWNERS with the disability can operate the golf cart.
- III. Disabled operators must have a current driver's license.
- IV. Carts must have liability insurance and a W.H.P. sticker purchased for \$35.00 each year.
- V. All carts must be electric.
- VI. Carts must have front and back lights if being used after dark.
- VII. Carts must be maintained in good working order.
- VIII. Carts cannot be parked on paved roads and Lot owners must have a designated parking area on their property to park their carts.
- IX. Carts can ONLY be used on paved roads except for the temporary parking in the overflow area at the marina.
- X. Owners are responsible for removing disabled carts from W.H.P. property.
- XI. Any violation of the rules and regulations will result in a notice of violation for the first offense
- XII. The second violation will result in a fine of \$50.00.
- XIII. The third violation will result in suspension of use of the cart in W.H.P.

The above agreement must be signed by the disable operator of the golf cart and a copy will be kept on file in the office.
