Boats and Trailers are not allowed to enter through the Timberline Circle Gate. All Boats and Trailers must have stickers.

Electric will be read on September 18 - 20. Invoices will be out by October 5 and will be due on November 5. Remember, this is your highest electric quarter as it covers the hottest and busiest time of the year. The second annual cable bill will be due on October 1st. Please refer to our payment schedule to ensure that you will not receive a late fee.

It is important to keep the dumpster doors closed. If you could please close them behind you, we would appreciate it. If left open, the racoons climb inside. Baby racoons have gotten trapped in them and if they can't get out, unfortunately when the

Media com

Media Com has changed the information concerning cable for the change in service. I was told today that if you already have a cable box you don't have to order a new one. The encryption will work with any box. If you want more than one box you must call Media Com @1-855-633-4226. You will

set up a separate account and be billed to your permanent address each month. The cost is \$10.50 per month.

If you do not have a box please call the office @ 410 641 5102. You will need a box to view anything on your tv. There is no cost to receive one box.

Scheduling will be announced by the Media Com Bulk Coordinator Team. We will keep you posted.
