### From the Park Manager:

I hope everyone is enjoying the month of June in White Horse Park. We're happy that you are all here. It's so nice to see the owners and visitors enjoying the beginning of summer and all our amenities. The pool is open daily and weekends. The Clubhouse has fun events planned throughout the summer. We thank those volunteers that make events happen. Bikes are available to borrow at the guard house or the office, and the marina has a lovely gazebo for relaxing and watching sunsets or sunrises. You may fish or crab there as well. We are excited about the summer here at WHP.

The Annual Meeting is on June 25<sup>th</sup> at Showell Elementary School on Route 589 at 10 AM. If you are turning in your ballot, you must do so by 9:30 AM. There will be a picnic afterwards at the Clubhouse. We are hoping for a large turnout to both.

The boatyard back parking lot has been cleaned of the mountain of debris recently. Please do NOT put anything back there. The area is off-limits to everyone.

The roll-off dumpster has been heavily used for the past month. Please, when it is full, it is full. Do not leave items next to the dumpster. Do not put things on top. All the items must be below the edge of the container. You only need to wait for the next empty dumpster to arrive. OFFICE REMINDERS

YARD WASTE: Bagged yard waste (only!) can now be placed on the trailer located next to the dumpsters. PLEASE DO NOT PUT ANY YARD DEBRIS OR TRASH IN THE BACK AREA OF BOAT STORAGE-WE ARE TRYING TO CLEAR THIS OUT. USE yard waste trailer near dumpsters

#### SUMMER HOURS:

Monday through Saturday 8 AM to 4 PM Bath Houses and Laundry open 6 AM to 11 PM daily Swimming Pool open Sun-Thurs. 10AM-8PM, Fri. & Sat. 10 AM - 10 PM

LARGE TRASH DUMPSTER: Will be available for your use through the month of June! Please load your items carefully and do not overfill the dumpster. It will be emptied regularly. Thank you for your considerate use of this service provided at no charge to you by your Board of Directors.

PLEASE SLOW DOWN! The speed limit in the park is 10 mph. Please observe the speed limit, and slow down on our narrow streets, which are especially busy now, with walkers, bikers, kids, pets and other vehicles.

### MARINA NEWS: I have been in contact with

the US Coast Guard Auxiliary, and have tentatively set up a visit from them to WHP to inspect boats on Saturday, June 18, 2022. This is the Saturday of Father's Day weekend. They will arrive in the Park at 10 AM, and can inspect your boat either on land, or in the water. Either way, there must be someone with your boat, with the boat's State Registration card in hand. Items inspected include, but are not limited to; lights, horn or some other audible warning device, fire extinguisher, flares (must not have an expired date), life jackets, and throw cushion. I believe first aid kits are asked about, but optional. Upon a successful completed inspection, the Coast Guard Auxiliary inspector will give you a sticker for your boat. When you have this sticker, usually (not guaranteed), you won't be inspected while on the water for the above items.

Also, I will plan to do a hot dog social starting around 11:30 AM, so we can include the Coast Guard personnel. *Volunteer help would be greatly appreciated with either directing the Coast Guard, and/or with the hot dog social*. Thanks. Phil Wood

NOTE: PLEASE DO NOT PUT YARD DEBRIS OR ANY TYPE OF TRASH IN THE BACK OF THE BOAT STORAGE AREA. We are trying to clear this out. Use yard debris trailer near dumpsters.

**ECC COMMITTEE UPDATE:** Annual Inspection is underway. The checklist is provided to give you notice that there are items that need attending to on your property. If you think you may be unable to complete the list by re-inspection date, please let us know when you can expect to have it completed. All sheds must have the house number clearly shown on them. The house number is very important and benefits the resident. If it is not visible, or hard to find, it could cause a delay for emergency response.
